

# **Master – Drilling Rig**

**Location: USA area** 

#### **FUNCTION**

You are leading the Marine department onboard the unit. The Master holds ultimate responsibility for the safe operation of the rig, crew welfare, and environmental protection. Acting as **Person in Charge (PIC)** under international law, the Master leads marine operations, ensures compliance with international and company standards, and provides decisive leadership during routine and emergency situations.

#### **CORE RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### Compliance & Standards

- Adhere to Code of Conduct, management system, policies, standards, and process documentation.
- Ensure operations meet State, Class, Flag, ISM, ISPS, SOLAS, MARPOL, SOPEP, and client requirements.
- Maintain valid marine certifications

# • Safety & Environmental Protection

- Hold overriding authority to act decisively for rig safety, crew welfare, and environmental protection.
- Lead hazard identification, risk control, and safe work practices (Permit to Work, Isolation procedures).
- o Report accidents and dangerous occurrences promptly.
- o Conduct regular emergency drills and ensure crew readiness.

## • Leadership & Team Management

- Ultimate responsibility for marine personnel competency, training, and coaching.
- o Participate as a member of the Unit Management Team.
- o Ensure clear communication across departments, crews, clients, and third parties.
- o Provide accurate handovers at shift and hitch changes.

#### Operational Oversight

- o Organize and supervise marine department activities.
- Plan, organize, and execute operations per rig move plans, anchor plans, well programs, and contractual obligations.
- Manage navigational watchkeeping, radio communications, helicopter, and boat operations.



- Support drilling operations with deck and marine equipment readiness.
- Participate in daily operational meetings (review past 24h, preview next 24–72h, plan future logistics).
- o Ensure all necessary mooring equipment are on board.

## • Maintenance & Housekeeping

- o Supervise paint/corrosion prevention and surface cleaning.
- o Ensure tanks are flushed with fresh water to prevent corrosion.
- Maintain ship communications, navigation, firefighting, lifesaving, and anchoring equipment.
- Uphold hygiene and housekeeping standards, keeping escape/walkways clear.

#### Audits & Continuous Improvement

- Assist with corporate and regulatory audits and inspections.
- o Contribute to QHSE planning and continual improvement initiatives.
- Focus on "doing things right the first time, every time."

#### Onboarding & Orientation

- o Implement offshore orientation and safety induction for new arrivals.
- o Ensure subordinates are functionally inducted.

**During anchor handling, the Master is in sole charge of operations**, working in conjunction with the client's Marine Representative and Captains of the Anchor Handling rig (AHVs). Responsibilities include:

- Holding pre-operation meetings to brief all parties and confirm responsibilities.
- Ensuring AHV Masters are aware of their tasks.
- Confirming survey package (if required) and rig radars are fully operational.
- Securing agreement from all parties before setting an anchor.
- Guiding AHVs at any time during operations as deemed necessary.
- Advising the office before making any alterations to proposed anchor positions.

#### **Authority:**

- The Master is designated as **Person In Charge (PIC)** under international law and flag state regulations.
- Normally, the rig is managed by a **Unit Management Team** consisting of the Master, Rig Superintendent, and Technical Section Leader, reporting to the Rig Manager.

- Valid national unlimited Master certificate of competence
- Seaman's book
- GMDSS General Operator's Certificate.
- Dynamic Positioning Training courses (plus other regulatory courses).
- All **STCW 95 training** required for Masters on the rig class and flag requirements.



- Valid Ship Security Officer Certificate.
- Valid Medical Examination.

## **†** Experience

 At least 2 years' master experience on an operational semi-submersible and five years operational experience on a DP and/or moored floating drilling rig.

- Excellent communication skills in English (oral and written).
